
AUTHORIZED STATE BANKING HOLIDAYS FOR YEAR 2008

Birthdays of George Washington & Thomas Jefferson	Monday, February 18, 2008
Confederate Memorial Day	Monday, April 28, 2008
National Memorial Day	Monday, May 26, 2008
Jefferson Davis' Birthday	Monday, June 2, 2008
Independence Day	Friday, July 4, 2008
Labor Day	Monday, September 1, 2008
Columbus Day	Monday, October 13, 2008
Veterans Day	Tuesday, November 11, 2008
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 27, 2008
Christmas Day*	Thursday, December 25, 2008

*Banks are also authorized to close at noon on Monday, December 31, 2007, and to close at noon Wednesday, December 24, 2008.
