CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

This matter came on to be heard on August 8, 2006, before W. Mark Anderson III, Deputy Attorney General for this Department, as duly appointed hearing officer. Present for the hearing were Linwood Bragan, Esq., Assistant Attorney General, representing the Department. Although notice was duly given to the Licensee, AAA Benefit Sales, Inc., no one appeared for the hearing on its behalf.


The Department presented the testimony of Jeremy Windham, an examiner for the Bureau of Loans, and introduced certain documentary evidence, showing that the Licensee has been conducting its business in a manner that is not consistent with the applicable laws, rules, and regulations.

AAA Benefit Planning, doing business as AAA Mortgage, is duly licensed by this Department. It is not licensed to do business as AAA Benefit Sales, doing business as Loan Pro, Inc. Nevertheless, the licensee has charged and collected fees in the name of those and other unlicensed companies. Such actions constitute mortgage brokerage

services which require that the entities charging fees for such services be licensed by this Department.

Therefore, it is recommended to the Supervisor that an Order issue forthwith requiring the Licensee to cease and desist from such activities.
