AUTHORIZED STATE BANKING HOLIDAYS FOR YEAR 2017

Pursuant to Section 1-3-8, Code of Alabama 1975, banks are authorized to observe the following holidays:

New Year's Day*	Sunday, January 1, 2017
Birthdays of Robert E. Lee & Martin Luther King, Jr.	Monday, January 16, 2017
Birthdays of George Washington & Thomas Jefferson	Monday, February 20, 2017
Confederate Memorial Day	Monday, April 24, 2017
National Memorial Day	Monday, May 29, 2017
Jefferson Davis' Birthday	Monday, June 5, 2017
Independence Day	Tuesday, July 4, 2017
Labor Day	Monday, September 4, 2017
Columbus Day	Monday, October 9, 2017
Veterans Day**	Saturday, November 11, 2017
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 23, 2017
Christmas Day	Monday, December 25, 2017

*Banks may close all day Monday, January 2, 2017, for the New Year's Day Holiday.

**Banks may also close all day Friday, November 10, 2017, to observe Veterans Day.

State banks and branches of state banks located in Baldwin and Mobile Counties may, if they choose, observe Tuesday, February 28, 2017, Mardi Gras Day, as a holiday.
