Pursuant to Section 1-3-8, Code of Alabama 1975, banks are authorized to observe the following holidays:

New Year's Day	Wednesday, January 1, 2020
Birthdays of Robert E. Lee & Martin Luther King, Jr.	Monday, January 20, 2020
Birthdays of George Washington & Thomas Jefferson	Monday, February 17, 2020
Confederate Memorial Day	Monday, April 27, 2020
National Memorial Day	Monday, May 25, 2020
Jefferson Davis's Birthday	Monday, June 1, 2020
Independence Day	Friday, July 3, 2020*
Labor Day	Monday, September 7, 2020
Columbus Day	Monday, October 12, 2020
Veterans Day	Wednesday, November 11, 2020
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 26, 2020
Christmas Day	Friday, December 25, 2020*

\* Banks are also authorized to close on Saturday, July 4, 2020, and Saturday, December 26, 2020; and to close at noon on Thursday, December 24, 2020, and at noon on Thursday, December 31, 2020.
